Therapeutic Exercise

Builds muscles, enhances joint mobility and improves cardiovascular health, balance and function in a controlled environment. Land treadmills, physioballs, balance boards trampolines, and cavaletti rails are some of the equipment used. Therapeutic exercise sessions are also perfect for improving overall physical fitness and training for specific events.

Hydrotherapy – Underwater Treadmill

Walking in water within a protected setting offers fast muscle redevelopment and improves coordination, joint health and cardiovascular fitness. Buoyancy ensures a safe, low-impact exercise environment and the warm water temperature (88°-92°F) increases circulation.

Hydrotherapy – Resistance Pool

Swimming is a great workout for dogs. In some rehabilitation cases the pool is used in lieu of the underwater treadmill. In other cases, pets often "graduate" to the pool for therapy maintenance and physical fitness. Our pool features jets that can be used for resistance swimming as well as warm water massage.

Massage and Passive Range of Motion (PROM)

Massage therapy increases joint mobility and flexibility, helps break down scar tissue, enhances healing and reduces stress. PROM is especially important right after surgery to increase circulation and reduce edema and pain. Many times heat is added to improve joint flexibility and/or cold to alleviate pain and decrease swelling.

Electrical Stimulation (E-stim)

Often used by professional athletes to recover from injury, electrical stimulation slows down muscle atrophy, increases circulation to the injury, relieves muscle spasms and decreases pain.

Low Level Laser Therapy

For more than 20 years lasers have been used on humans for a number of therapeutic purposes. Recently the technology has been made available to pets for pain management in relation to scar tissue, edema and wound healing with no reported side effects.

Nutrition Analysis and Counseling

Proper diet and nutrition is a critical component to healing, prevention and wellness. We can provide advice on the best diet for your pet and recommend foods to achieve specific health goals.

Veterinary Orthopedic Manipulation (VOM)

VOM focuses on realigning the spinal column, ultimately reducing pain and improving function of joints and tissue. VOM can also correct secondary problems resulting from the pet compensating for an injury. For pets with other ailments such as nervous system disorders, organ dysfunction, muscle weakness or chronic back/neck pain, VOM can help restore nerve function to certain areas.
